



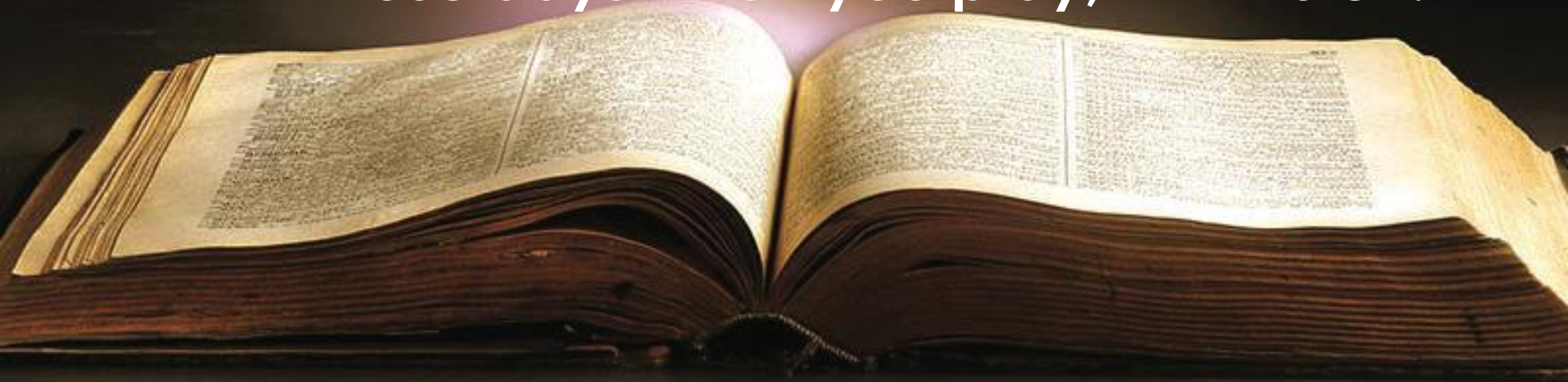

12 In those days when you pray, I will listen.

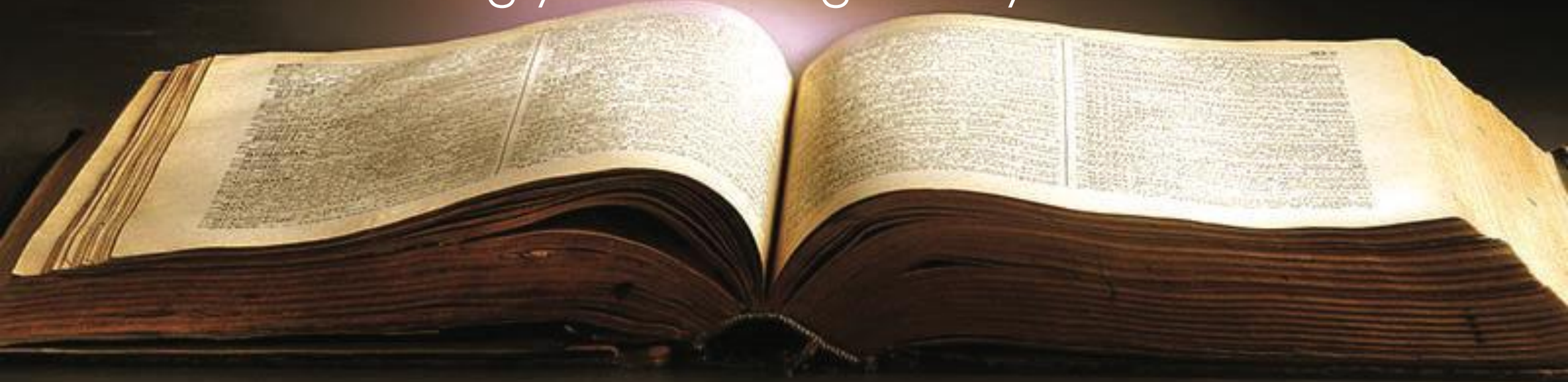


Jeremiah 29:13-14 (NLT2)
